

Manning Public Library Behavior Policy

We encourage people to use the Manning Public Library. We reserve the right to enforce the following rules to insure the library is enjoyable for all.

1. No food or drink is allowed in the library unless specified by the librarian.
2. Please keep your voice at a level that will not bother other patrons.
3. Please stay home if you are ill. Germs spread quickly in a public library.
4. No running, arguing, shouting, or profane/offensive language is to be used in the library, including library meeting rooms.
5. It is not always possible during inclement weather, but try to avoid bringing in mud or snow on your shoes.
6. Return library materials on time. If you need to renew library materials, contact the library by phone, email, or facebook. More information can be found in the library's Circulation Policy.
7. Parents, not library staff, are responsible for their children when they bring them to the library. Parents must have control of their child at all times to insure the child's safety in the library and to insure the child is not disruptive to other library patrons and staff. If a child is left after the library closes, the police-not the parents- will be contacted.
8. Library staff may ask any patron to leave the library if they or their child are a disturbance to other patrons or staff.
9. Computers are here for the public use and are regulated under the library's Behavior Policy as well as the library's Internet and Technology Policy.
