The buildings have housed: Manning Heating & Sheet Metal, Manning Equipment Repair, Manning Foods, West Street Market



John Miller constructed a building at Hwy. 141 and West Street in 1960 where he carried Allis Chalmers Equipment. He discontinued sales in 1970 and operated as an implement repair shop until 1977. Charles Rauch constructed a new 70x180-foot building just south of Miller's building and operated Manning Heating and Sheet Metal.

In 1987, Manning Equipment Repair and its new Hesston equipment line quickly grew to the largest dealer in the region, and in 1988 moved into the building which formerly housed Manning Heating and Sheet Metal.

Manning Equipment Repair closed in 1992 and in 1993 Garrett and Patricia Littlejohn purchased (and united?) the building when they established Manning Foods providing groceries and a delicatessen. In June 2013 the business was purchased by Dawn Lorenzen and Amy Osborne who renamed the business West Street Market.
